OLD TESTAMENT LESSON: Deuteronomy 34:1-12

1 Then Moses went up from the plains of Moab to Mount Nebo, to the top of Pisgah, which is opposite Jericho, and the LORD showed him the whole land: Gilead as far as Dan, **2** all Naphtali, the land of Ephraim and Manasseh, all the land of Judah as far as the Western Sea, **3** the Negeb, and the Plain—that is, the valley of Jericho, the city of palm trees—as far as Zoar. **4** The LORD said to him, “This is the land of which I swore to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, saying, ‘I will give it to your descendants.’ I have let you see it with your eyes, but you shall not cross over there.” **5** Then Moses, the servant of the LORD, died there in the land of Moab, at the LORD’s command. **6** He buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, opposite Beth-peor, but no one knows his burial place to this day. **7** Moses was one hundred twenty years old when he died; his sight was unimpaired, and his vigor had not abated. **8** The Israelites wept for Moses in the plains of Moab thirty days; then the period of mourning for Moses was ended. **9** Joshua son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom because Moses had laid his hands on him, and the Israelites obeyed him, doing as the LORD had commanded Moses. **10** Never since has there arisen a prophet in Israel like Moses, whom the LORD knew face to face. **11** He was unequalled for all the signs and wonders that the LORD sent him to perform in the land of Egypt, against Pharaoh and all his servants and his entire land, **12** and for all the mighty deeds and all the terrifying displays of power that Moses performed in the sight of all Israel.

ANTHEM Lead On, O King Eternal**NEW TESTAMENT LESSON:** Acts 2:14-36

14 But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them, “Fellow Jews and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say. **15** Indeed, these are not drunk, as you suppose, for it is only nine o’clock in the morning. **16** No, this is what was spoken through the prophet Joel:

17 ‘In the last days it will be, God declares,
that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh,
and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy,
and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams.

18 Even upon my slaves, both men and women,
in those days I will pour out my Spirit,
and they shall prophesy.

19 And I will show portents in the heaven above
and signs on the earth below,
blood, and fire, and smoky mist.

20 The sun shall be turned to darkness
and the moon to blood,
before the coming of the Lord's great and glorious day.

21 Then everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.'

22 "Fellow Israelites, listen to what I have to say: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with deeds of power, wonders, and signs that God did through him among you, as you yourselves know— **23** this man, handed over to you according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of those outside the law. **24** But God raised him up, having released him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for him to be held in its power. **25** For David says concerning him, 'I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand so that I will not be shaken;

26 therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced;
moreover, my flesh will live in hope.

27 For you will not abandon my soul to Hades
or let your Holy One experience corruption.

28 You have made known to me the ways of life;
you will make me full of gladness with your presence.'

29 "Fellow Israelites, I may say to you confidently of our ancestor David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. **30** Since he was a prophet, he knew that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would put one of his descendants on his throne. **31** Foreseeing this, David spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, saying,

'He was not abandoned to Hades,
nor did his flesh experience corruption.'

32 "This Jesus God raised up, and of that all of us are witnesses. **33** Being therefore exalted at [g] the right hand of God and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you see and hear. **34** For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says,

'The Lord said to my Lord,
"Sit at my right hand,

35 until I make your enemies your footstool."

36 "Therefore let the entire house of Israel know with certainty that God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified."
