

ARDATH REGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The **ARDATH REGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** is a \$500 scholarship. It is awarded to one graduating high school senior who is also a member of the Holly Presbyterian Church. In the event that there are no high school graduating seniors, students who are entering their second year of advanced schooling, who have not previously received this scholarship may apply for the scholarship that year. The purpose of the scholarship is to help allow a deserving student to attend a college, university or trade school of their choice.

The application must include:

- **The application form**
- **An essay of 500 words or less**
- **Two letters of recommendation from adults who are not relatives**

The following criteria will be used by the Holly Presbyterian Church Session to determine the winner:

- **2.5 GPA or better**
- **Graduating Senior planning to take advanced education**
- **Extra-curricular activities**
- **Financial need**

Applications need to be returned to the Holly Presbyterian Church Office prior to April 15th of the application year. Applicants will be contacted with the results by a current Session member.

The monetary award will be sent directly to the institution selected. Recipients must submit a copy of the admissions letter and the address of the institution's financial office to Holly Presbyterian Church 207 E. Maple St. Holly, MI 48442 Attn: HPC Treasurer. Any financial aid and/or tuition payment deadlines need to be noted to allow sufficient time to process payment. In the event that the recipient becomes ineligible to receive the award, the next ranked applicant will be given the scholarship. **If there are any questions, contact the Holly Presbyterian Church Office 248-634-9494.**
